Application Process



Apply

Apply online. Choose your Category, submit references and supporting documents. Application Fee of \$83+GST is applicable upon submission.



Process

The process takes 4-6 weeks. Secretary submits to board for approval once a month and to members forum for feedback. Due diligence is carried out by all.



Outcome

The secretary will inform the applicant in writing if membership has been accepted or declined. If accepted, a Membership Certificate and Welcome pack is sent and announcements are made publicly on all communications.

Membership Options

Category A

\$**448**+GST

Owner or Operator with no employees

Category B

\$**599**+GST

A business that employs staff, with a total number of full-time equivalent employees or contractors (including the owner/operator, assuming he/she works in the business) of three or fewer.

Category C

\$815+GST

A business that employs staff, with a total number of full-time equivalent employees or contractors (including the owner/operator, assuming he/she works in the business) of more than three.

Multi-Site

\$448+GST

A business franchise group or multi-sites that hold the same business name and employs a total number of full-time equivalent employees or contractors (including the owner/operator, assuming he/she works in the business) of more than three at each site.

Note: There must be one main site that holds a full Category C Membership to be eligible for the multi-site membership.

Associate

\$448+GST

Company representative or trade supplier/associate to the industry.

Retired

\$50+GST

At the Executive Boards' discretion, this membership may be given to an individual for outstanding service, and exceptional contribution and who is highly regarded by peers within the industry and whose contribution has been for an extended period of time.

The Criteria

The vision of criteria underpins the Master Sign Maker Accreditation Learn, Connect and Craft.

To be eligible you must be a trade qualified sign maker OR have had at least 5 years' experience within the industry as a business owner and have been a NZSDA member for 2 or more years.

Event Networking

The NZSDA hosts regional and national events year-round, offering opportunities to learn connect and craft with industry leaders and peers within the nationwide network of like minded Sign Makers.

Sign Makers Conference

The NZSDA Conference is the place to network and learn from established leaders and experts. The conference has been running for over 60 years and is the longest running industry event.
